



MBA/CETA INTERNSHIPS

The East Cape MBA is currently facilitating an Internship Programme for Workplace Integrated Learning (WIL) on in conjunction with the Construction SETA (CETA). Internships are intended for tertiary students requiring experiential learning in the building industry and who are following a recognized tertiary course of study which falls within the CETA's mandate.

The requirements and details of which are as follows:

a. Eligibility

Students:

1. Who have successfully completed the necessary prior year's tuition in a Building related qualification at recognized tertiary institutions;
2. Who meet the minimum academic requirements for acceptance;
3. Who are South African Citizens.

b. Nature of Internships (Costs Covered)

Internship costs covered include Stipends, workplace fees, mentorship, etc. subject to the limitations as set by the MBA from time to time.

c. Institutions

Universities, offering Degree/Diploma courses in the building industry including Construction Management, Building & Human Settlements Development, Quantity Surveying, Architecture, etc. or any other qualification approved by the CETA.

d. Entry Qualifications/Requirements/Criteria

1. Interns must have passed the required year of study prior to entering the WIL Internship programme;
2. Interns are not to hold any other bursaries which bind them to enter a service contract.
3. Any other criteria prescribed by the CETA from time to time.

e. Contract

1. Enter into an Internship Agreement with the MBA/CETA as required;
2. Interns must accept placement for any periods of WIL as necessary for the relevant qualification and be prepared to move to different employers as may be required from time to time and as circumstances dictate.

1. Stipends are to be paid directly to Interns/Host Employer on a monthly basis subject to funding being made available from CETA;
2. Attendance registers must be completed by the host employer and submitted to the MBA on a monthly basis;
3. Stipends will be adjusted based on attendance at the sole discretion of the MBA;
4. Workplace fees will be paid to host employers at the discretion of the MBA.
